We can keep data like:

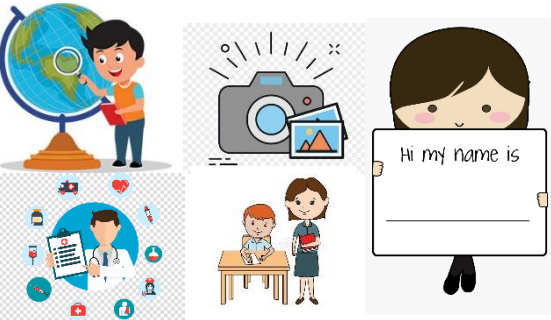
- Your name and address
