

Our school uniform

Our aim is that children should be tidy, comfortable and ready to work. Our 'colour scheme' is red, black and white.

We would like to move from grey to black over the course of 2018-19 as we are aware that some children will already have grey skirts, trousers, etc. From September 2019, we will expect all children to wear black.

- Winter: plain black skirt, pinafore dress or culottes
black long trousers
plain white shirt or white polo shirt (to wear under jumpers / cardigans)
red sweatshirt or cardigan with school logo
plain black, or white socks or black tights
sensible shoes (no heels or 'Ugg' style boots)
- Summer: any of the above and/or:-
Gingham or striped red and white dress
tailored black short trousers
red short-sleeved polo shirt with logo
sensible shoes or sandals (no heels, 'flip-flops' or 'sliders')

Please note plain red sweatshirts or cardigans can be bought; however the logo helps us to create a universal shared identity.

P.E. KIT:

Children need to come into school dressed for P.E. The kit is as follows:-

- Indoor: black P.E. shorts
plain round-neck red T-shirt (no replica sport shirts or polo shirts)
trainers
(black jogging pants or tracksuit bottoms and black plain sweatshirt or hoodie
can be worn over the top of kit on cooler days)
- Outdoor: trainers
black jogging pants or tracksuit bottoms
black plain sweatshirt or hoodie
Swimming - swimming costumes/shorts and towels for swimming

For safety reasons, pupils are not allowed to wear jewellery, e.g. rings, necklaces, bracelets, drop earrings. Stud earrings are allowed but must be removed for P.E. and swimming. Boots or Wellingtons may be worn to school, but shoes should be worn indoors. Shoes should be flat as many of our children need to use the stairs.
