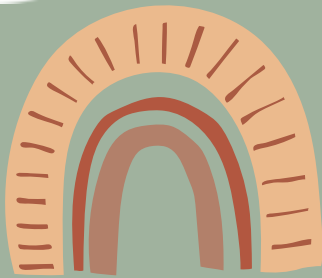

Year 1- 90.7%

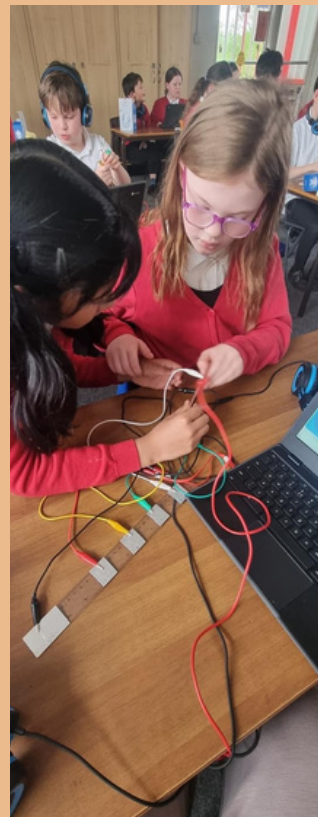
Year 2-100%
